Superintendent Bennett told the Board that she had reached out for possible financing options for the HVAC project at Clarksville Middle School. She introduced Mr. Mike Therber from Therber & Brock and Mr. Jeffery Qualkinbush from Barnes & Thornburg. Mr. Qualkinbush said CCSC was soon to be out of much of its debt and now would be a good time for bonds. He noted that the Clarksville High School Building Corporation would be used for the project. He said the timeline is similar to years past and that next week the lease would be up for approval. He said the bond project would not result in any tax increases. Mr. Therber noted that \$2.25 million would cover HVAC and lighting as well as other projects district-wide. He noted the bond repayment schedule would be aggressive.
