The Board of School Trustees of the Clarksville Community School Corporation met in Room A-17 of Clarksville Middle School, 101 Ettel Lane, Clarksville, Indiana on Tuesday, February 9, 2016. All Board members were present.

Call to Order

Mr. Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Dr. Knott updated the board about the NEOLA policies and administrative guidelines being almost caught up. She says many will remain intact and don't need changes.

Dr. Knott discussed Sister Cities and whether the board should set a policy concerning trips overseas in light of the recent terrorist attack in Paris. Mr. Wilson says the issue needs to be looked at fully to make sure everyone is protected.

Dr. Knott reminded board members about a Special Education Coop meeting at Greater Clark County on Thursday, February 11, 2016.
