Education Update

Superintendent Bennett told the Board to review the draft of the proposed start and end times for the 2018-2019 school year. She noted the times would soon be finalized and that she planned to bring them back for a vote. She said the change would mean an additional 40 minutes per day of instructional time for elementary students and would reduce the number of bus routes by being able to tier busing. Superintendent Bennett reminded the Board about the Showcase of Schools on April 11 and 12.

Bullington reminded the Board about a proposal to change the school mascot from Chargers to Generals. She said it would build unity and be fiscally sound. She said she had collected data from 68.5% of the student body. Of the 289 responses, 73% said yes. The Board said Ms. Bullington should go ahead and move forward. Superintendent Bennett told the Board there would be a SWAT walk through on April 10. Superintendent Bennett gave the Board a listing of all smaller project contracts and said they will updated as they are completed. Superintendent Bennett also gave the Board a timeline for the Makespace! marketing campaign. She said it would begin April 18 and run through September 18.
