Call to Order

Mr. Wilson called the Planning Session to order at 7:35 p.m.

Amend and/or Adopt Agenda

Ms. Hauber made a motion to adopt the agenda, as presented. Ms. Wilson seconded; the vote was unanimous.

Education Update

Superintendent Bennett said the Leadership team had a mini strategic planning retreat to work on the Corporation strategic plan that was started by the Board members last year. Superintendent Bennett said Clarksville Elementary School's Pre School program was getting attention from the Early Childhood Center at the DOE for its highly effective inclusive practices. She noted that teacher, Ms. Julie Seigle, had been invited to participate in an interview and survey process. Superintendent Bennett noted that the DOE has requested that Clarksville High School be a host site for a regional professional development on Literacy in June. She also noted that the IDOE literacy framework video featuring CES would be released in the coming months. Superintendent Bennett said that 10 of the 39 seniors who signed up still are still on track to receive a Governor's Work Ethic Certification, three more than last year. She also said six students have earned an MSSC industry certification through the HIRE Technology program. Superintendent Bennett noted that the Faulkner Relays were scheduled for May 2, 2019 and the track will be renamed for Darrell Kingery. She also said Clarksville High School would be hosting a Softball Sectional. Superintendent Bennett presented the Board with some upcoming dates of events in the Corporation, including May 13, 2019 for the Teacher of the Year Corporation announcement and celebration and Graduation on May 31, 2019. Superintendent Bennett noted a new Frisbee Club being started by Physical Education Teacher, Mr. Kristopher Hortemiller. She said students would learn the game of Ultimate Frisbee with the goal to compete against other schools in the area.

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Superintendent's Reports

Superintendent Bennett said the State Board of Accounts had completed their audit for the dates of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018 and had minimal findings. She said an exit interview is scheduled for April 23, 2019. Superintendent Bennett updated the Board on the Corporation Wellness Committee. She said goals are to increase awareness of the importance of a healthy lifestyle and to increase usage of a wellness app which could ultimately help lower health insurance premiums Corporation wide. Superintendent Bennett said CCSC would be First Savings Bank Corporation Wide by May 1, 2019. Superintendent Bennett said that Ms. Holly Rupperecht, Assistant to the Superintendent, received training and is an official notary public for the State of Indiana. She will serve as the Corporation notary.

Comments

C. E. A. Communications: Ms. Janet Wagner, C.E.A. President, said she saw many people at the Friends and Family Night and they had a great time. She said Clarksville Middle School is looking great and commended the workers on the HVAC project for being very nice and respectful. She noted that students are getting ready for the ILEARN. She also mentioned Senate Bill 390 that would only allow teachers to meet three times to discuss bargaining issues.

Comments from Board Members: Ms. Wilson said she loved the talent show at the Clarksville Middle School Friends and Family Night. Mr. Wilson said the ISTA, IASBO, ISBA, IAPSS and the Indiana Coalition for Public Education have been working on a law that could give more funding to school districts in Indiana.


