Education Update

Superintendent Bennett noted that the IREAD and ISTEP have been completed in all buildings. She said IREAD scores are embargoed and the retest is scheduled for June. Superintendent Bennett told the Board about recent trips made by high school and renaissance students to a career fair, Purdue University Engineering Expo and the Vex Robotics International Championship. Superintendent Bennett noted that due to the later start time for Clarksville Elementary School next school year that Communities in Schools would offer the Before School Extended Day Learning (EDL) Program from 6:30-7:50 a.m.

Superintendent's Reports

Superintendent Bennett shared a letter from the SWAT team commending the safety at Clarksville High School. She updated the Board on a student memorial tree at Clarksville High School that is damaged and needs to be removed. She said she has worked with the student's mother in selecting a replacement. Superintendent Bennett updated the Board on the Teacher of the Year program. She said all building level winners had been announced and that a Corporation winner would be chosen later in the month. She said all winners would be honored in June. Superintendent Bennett commended Clarksville Middle School's handling of the "Hit of Hell" Documentary, which focuses on the opioid epidemic. Marketing/Showcase Update

Superintendent Bennett said registration for the next school year is open and that the buildings have an internal competition to get students signed up early. She also mentioned that Ms. Tara Schmelz would have a full update next week on the showcase event.

Facility Project Update

Superintendent Bennett introduced Mr. Rick Jackson, Director of Facilities and Operations. Mr. Jackson told the Board the bids for the Clarksville Middle School HVAC project were not awarded. He said it would be rebid in June. He updated the Board on painting, carpeting, renovation to the tennis court and striping in the parking lots. He also noted new signage would be made for many areas. Mr. Jackson noted there is money remaining from previous bond projects that is being used to complete the updates.

Superintendent Bennett told the Board that she has updated the Administrative Guideline #7310 in regards to surplus ahead of the facility projects. She said any surplus over \$250 would be brought to the Board for approval.
