Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Wilson called the Planning Session to order at 7:30 p.m. and asked those in attendance to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Amend and/or Adopt Agenda

Ms. Wilson made a motion to adopt the agenda, as presented. Ms. Hauber seconded; the vote was unanimous.

Student of the Month Recognition

Superintendent Bennett honored the students of the month for May. Alexandra Camilo from Clarksville Elementary School, Jackson Mullins from Clarksville Middle School and Gabriel Petri from Renaissance Academy were all in attendance. Allison Balmer from Clarksville High School was unable to attend.

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Teacher of the Year Recognition

Superintendent Bennett recognized the teachers of the year for Clarksville Community Schools. Kelsie Crandall from Clarksville Elementary School, Amy Clere from Clarksville High School and Renaissance Academy and Cindy Taylor from Clarksville Middle School were all in attendance. Superintendent Bennett said Cindy Taylor was also the corporation Teacher of the Year and will be put in for consideration for Indiana Teacher of the Year.

Education Update

Superintendent Bennett noted that Clarksville Elementary School had been randomly selected to participate in a large national assessment for fourth grade students. She said that 7 students at Clarksville High School and Renaissance Academy had earned the Governor's Work Ethic Certification. Superintendent Bennett noted the initial ISTEP scores would be released later in the month. Superintendent Bennett discussed potential pilot programs at Clarksville Middle School and Clarksville High School including E-Learning days and an alternative to the OSS Program. She also noted that 248 parents completed a recent parent survey and that the information would go towards helping set future goals. Superintendent Bennett also discussed several recent professional development opportunities for teachers.

Superintendent's Reports

Superintendent Bennett noted that bids were received for the Clarksville Middle School HVAC project and that she would be ready to bring back a recommendation later in the week during a special meeting. She noted the bonds for the project would soon be sold and that CCSC had received a bond rating of an A+ with a negative watch. Superintendent Bennett congratulated Christi Pruitt for completing her certification to become Chief Business Officer for the Corporation. She noted Adrienne Goldman had been accepted into the Leadership Southern Indiana 2019 Discover Class. Superintendent Bennett said she was asked to be a member of the One Southern Indiana Board. Superintendent Bennett also said that the application has been submitted for the School and Community Nutrition Community Eligibility Provision. If CCSC is approved, students would receive free breakfast and lunch. She also reminded the Board about the regular meeting moved to June 19th.

C. E. A. Communications: Mr. Alan Kashtai, C.E.A. Vice President, congratulated Cindy Taylor on being named CCSC Teacher of the Year.

Comments from Citizens: Mr. Alan Kashtai, CMS Teacher, signed up to speak. He expressed concerns about staffing. Those concerns included his Special Education position at Clarksville Middle School being eliminated and the interview process for a similar position at Clarksville Elementary School.

Comments from Board Members: Ms. Wilson said the excellence with teachers and students is amazing. Mr. Wilson thanked Superintendent Bennett for all she has done and noted the culture had changed at Clarksville Community Schools.

Superintendent Bennett discussed several personnel items.

Contracts for Facility Projects

Superintendent Bennett gave Board members an updated spreadsheet for the summer facility projects. She noted she would have members tour the buildings closer to the start of school so they could see all that has been done.

2018/2019 Textbook Rental Fees and Consumables

Superintendent Bennett presented the 2018/2019 textbook rental fees and consumables for all buildings.

2018/2019 Student Handbooks

Superintendent Bennett updated the Board on the student handbooks for next school year. She noted all changes were highlighted.

2018/2019 Faculty Handbooks

Superintendent Bennett also asked the Board to review the faculty handbooks for the 2018/2019 school year and noted any changes would also be highlighted.

2018/2019 Athletic Manual

Superintendent Bennett presented the athletic manual for next school year and noted some changes and additions.

Superintendent Bennett presented the 2018/2019 bus routes. She noted that they included the consolidation of the middle, high school and Renaissance Academy routes.
