Clarksville Higher Education Scholarship. Student must have a need for financial assistance to further his/her education, and must be attending a post-secondary institution.*
Clarksville Education Association Scholarship. Students must be planning to enter the field of education.
Clarksville Optimist Club. Friend of Youth scholarship. All college-bound graduates are eligible to apply.
Clarksville Middle School PTO Scholarship. Student must have attended CMS all 3 years.
Clarksville Elementary PTO Scholarship. Students must have attended CES, CMS, and either CHS or RA.
Eva Jo Franz Athletic Scholarship / Kathryn Chaney Scholarship. Recipients must be two-sport athletes with the highest GPA and have financial need. If recipient receives a full scholarship, the award will go to the next student-athlete who qualifies and has financial need. Scholarships will be awarded to one male and one female student. Must submit first semester university grades by March 1 to receive scholarship funds.**
Your Community Bank Charitable Foundation, IncWes Banco. Must have GPA of 2.4 on 4.0 scale. Must be a Core 40, AHD, THD graduate. Must have passed both sections of the ECA/ISTEP+. Must be a resident of Clark or Floyd county. Must be planning to attend an accredited four year college or university.
James Todd Swearingen Memorial Scholarship. Must have an unweighted GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale. Must be accepted into and attend an accredited two or four year public or private college or university. First preference will be given to those who have demonstrated an emphasis in the study of any foreign language during their high school years. 2 nd preference given to those pursuing post-secondary academic study in the field of a foreign language.
Bill Conley Memorial Scholarship. Students must be planning to enter the field of education. Must have GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale. Must submit first semester university grades by March 1 to receive scholarship funds.**
Kelly Bryant Memorial Athletic Scholarship. Must have GPA of 2.5 on 4.0 scale and a letter of acceptance to an accredited college or university. Must have participated in high school sports for at least three years, with one year being graduating year. Include a 250 words or less short essay, stating: "The Impact high school sports has had on my life."*
Alan K. Wilson Football Memorial Scholarship. Must have a GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale. Must have played football for a minimum of three years. Include a 200 words or less short essay, stating: "What football/being part of a team has meant to me."
Alumni Association Scholarship. Student must plan to further education and have a need for financial assistance. Must have a GPA of 2.5 on 4.0 scale. Must have demonstrated leadership and participation throughout his/her years at CHS/RA.**
Ronald L. Barr Memorial Scholarship. Must have a GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale. Must be a resident of Clarksville, IN. Applicant must attend Indiana University-Bloomington or Indiana University Southeast.
Clark Memorial Medical Staff Scholarship. Must be planning to go into a medical field.
