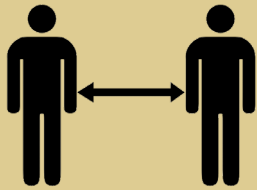


2020/21 Reopening Plan



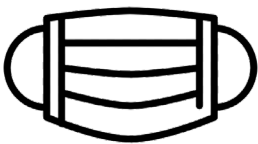
- The same group of children will stay with the same staff as much as possible
- Large classes will be reorganized to allow for smaller classes, social distancing, and other precautions
- Assemblies, field trips, registrations, orientations, and other large gatherings are eliminated until further notice to allow for social distancing
- Recess will be alternated to minimize the number of students on the playground
- Desks and classrooms will be rearranged to increase space between students



- Clarksville Community Schools recommends students and staff self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms at home prior to the start of the school day
- Students and staff will be screened on a random basis at the discretion of CCSC.
- Immunization requirements will remain the same
- Students may be sent home if they exhibit one or more of the symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19
- CCSC will work with the Clark County Health Department



- Students will be **required** to wear a face covering on the bus
- Students will be limited to one bus route only and will have assigned seats
- Students will not be permitted to ride another route or ride home with friends.
- Parents are encouraged to transport their student(s) when possible or allow students to walk and ride a bike when safe to do so



- All staff will be required to wear a face covering when unable to be socially distanced
- Visitors will be required to wear a face covering and are required to provide their own, but visitors will be limited wherever possible
- Students are **required** to wear facial coverings when social distancing is not possible. Health issues will be addressed on a case-by-case basis.



- Self-serve food items will be eliminated until further notice
- Food-sharing will be prohibited
- Classroom parties will not be held until further notice
- Eating on the bus is prohibited unless medically necessary



- As some people have COVID-19 but no symptoms, the three most important mitigation strategies are social distancing, frequent handwashing, and appropriate PPE
- Water fountains will not be utilized in schools until further notice, however, fill stations will be available for students and staff
- Cleaning and sanitizing will take place frequently and thoroughly
