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Dear Parents and Guardians,

We appreciate your continued support and patience as we work toward a safe and mindful start to the 2020/21 school year. We know that the safety of your child is in our hands, and we do not take the task lightly.

With this in mind, we are making some adjustments in a way that we believe keeps our students, staff, and community safe while still providing high-quality education. We are **not** changing our calendar, but rather switching to a hybrid model for the first two days of school and remote learning for the two weeks after that.

Students in grades K-12 whose last name starts with the letter A - K will come to school as scheduled Aug. 6th. Students in grades K-12 whose last name starts with the letter L - Z will come to school as scheduled Aug.

7th. Parents with students enrolled in our preschool program will receive separate instructions regarding the start of school.

We will be providing transportation and meals as usual on these two days and attendance will be taken. Students will have the chance to meet their teachers and classmates, receive their devices, and learn more about their classes and expectations for in-person and remote learning. Please note, our remote learning expectations and accountability will be much more rigorous than those at the onset of COVID-19.
