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Dear Parents and Guardians,

We continue to be appreciative of your patience, grace, and trust as we work to provide a safe and engaging educational experience for our students and staff during these challenging times.

As we have communicated prior, our reopening plan has been reviewed and approved by the Clark County Health Department for our district to operate at full capacity. At this time, we are prepared to fully implement this plan and bring all of our students back on campus for in-person instruction beginning Aug. 24. Safety measures as outlined in the plan will be in place, including required facial coverings when social distancing is not possible, assigned seating in the classrooms, the cafeterias, and on the buses. We are also implementing extra handwashing and sanitizing procedures, which are also outlined in this plan. We are reminding parents to screen students for symptoms at home before sending them to school. If your student is awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test, do not send your student to school.
