#### Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Wilson called the Regular Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and asked those in attendance to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Amend and/or Adopt Agenda

Ms. Wilson made a motion to adopt the agenda, as presented. Ms. Cummings seconded; the vote was unanimous.

#### Acknowledgements and Recognitions

Superintendent Bennett honored Evan Parker and Kolten Tyler, the students of the month for November and December from Clarksville Elementary School. Connor Page, the student of the month for December from Clarksville High School was also in attendance.

#### **Reports of School & Organization Representatives**

Superintendent's Reports: Superintendent Bennett noted that Clark County had moved into the red zone. She said she had a conversation with Dr. Yazel regarding an internal sign up process for staff members should the COVID-19 vaccine become available prior to the official rollout for education. She reported no current staffing issues regarding quarantine and says CCSC will take things one day at a time. She said extra-curricular sporting activities are currently limited to immediate family and school personnel only. Superintendent Bennett congratulated the boys' basketball team for winning the City Championship. She noted this is the first time since 2012 that CCSC boys have won both the football and basketball City Championships in the same year. She also noted the girls have won more games this season than in the

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past 10 years. Superintendent Bennett said the next count day is February 1. She said currently there are 1170 students attending the brick and mortar school, up 23 since September.

Dr. Brian Allred, Assistant Superintendent, reported the total enrollment for Indiana Gateway Digital Academy is 2714. That includes 124 CCSC students. He also reported that the refresher training on testing security was underway.

#### Adult Meal Prices for the 2020/2021 School Year

Superintendent Bennett said the 10 cent increase was due to compliance with the Community Eligibility Provision guidelines. Ms. Hauber seconded the motion; the vote was unanimous.

Upon Superintendent Bennett's recommendation, Mr. Hansford made a motion to approve the Bank Statements, Claims and Payroll, as presented. They are: 12/9 \$155,033.00, 12/9 \$95,246.54, 12/17

#### Other

Superintendent Bennett asked the Board to review the Fiscal ECA reports for all buildings. She noted that there is no voting action required but they need to be reviewed for the Internal Controls process.

Mr. Wilson reported that he had attended the audit entrance meeting and was bothered by how it is being conducted this year. He said the state and federal audits would be conducted separately with no notification ahead of time. He noted this will result in CCSC having to pay more money.
