Dyslexia Report 2020-21

- 1. Dyslexia Intervention Program used in 2020-2021:
 - a. Clarksville Community School Corporation provided reading intervention through our schoolwide Title I program and services.
 - b. Clarksville Community School Corporation used Phonics First, an Orton-Gillingham based phonics program, to intervene with students in grades 1st and 2nd who displayed characteristics of dyslexia. Students were also placed in the Amira online reading program. Students in kindergarten received Heggerty Phonemic Awareness intervention.
