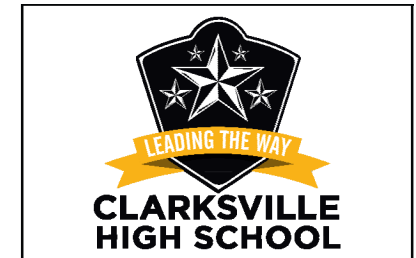
Payment Options: Online at www.sendmoneynoschool.com
