- Effectively monitor student learning. This would include but is not limited to, observing and recording all student data related to classroom activities and assessments, providing student interventions as indicated by the data collected through observations, communicating with stakeholders regarding student learning and behavior needs.
- Effectively assume duties associated with classroom management (i.e. attendance records/reporting, grade records/reporting, lesson planning, parent/guardian communication, etc.)
- Effectively implement school and board adopted policies, procedures and practices.
- Effectively implement other duties as assigned by the Principal and/or Assistant Principal.
