She said students who pass as 2nd graders won't have to take it as 3rd graders. Superintendent Bennett reminded the Board that next week's board meeting is the 1028 hearing for the upcoming bond issue. Superintendent Bennett congratulated the Lady Generals who were named to the Hoosier Basketball Coaches Association honors court for their academic performance. She said the team had a 3.4 team GPA. Superintendent Bennett told the Board that the ISBA spring meeting was April 26. She also reminded everyone about the Showcase of Schools on March 17 at all buildings.

Ms. Becca Gibson updated the Board on marketing efforts, including most recent newspaper ads, commercials and mailers.

Dr. Brian Allred, Assistant Superintendent, said registration is open for the On My Way Pre-K program and that 52 people have already signed up their students. Dr. Allred said Indiana Gateway Digital Academy is currently had 2429 enrollment and that they are happy to be in their new space on campus. Dr. Allred said SAT testing is completed. He noted this is the first year juniors have to take it for graduation.

Dr. Bennett also reported to the Board that she had talked with Dr. Jenner, head of the Indiana Department of Education, who complimented Clarksville Community Schools on efforts to keep students in school during COVID-19.
