Clarksville Community Schools proudly participate in the School Breakfast Program along with the National School Lunch Program. School Breakfast is served at each of our school locations: Renaissance Academy, Clarksville HS, Clarksville MS, & Clarksville Elementary.

Because CCSC participates in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) this means that ALL students can eat School Breakfast (& Lunch) for FREE!  
ALL students are welcomed and encouraged to participate on a daily basis.

Daily breakfast menus include fruit choice/juice, variety of whole grain cereal options, and various protein options according to each school's breakfast menu along with fat-free milk varieties. All foods offered are compliant with Federal, State, & USDA guidelines.
