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Dyslexia Report 2022-2023

- 1. Dyslexia Intervention Program used in 2022-2023:
 - a. Clarksville Community School Corporation provided reading intervention through our schoolwide Title I program and services.
 - b. Clarksville Community School Corporation used Phonics First, an Orton-Gillingham based phonics program, to intervene with students in grades Kdg - 3rd who displayed characteristics of dyslexia. Students were also placed in the Amira online reading program. Students in kindergarten - 2nd received Heggerty Phonemic Awareness lessons for the whole class.
 - c. The Amira dyslexia screener determined that the following number of students to be at risk or at some risk of dyslexia in grades K-2.
