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Dyslexia Report 2024-2025

- 1. Science of Reading aligned program used in 2024-2025:
 - a. Clarksville Community School Corporation provided reading intervention through our schoolwide Title I program and services.
 - b. At the Tier One level in grades K-2, students received Heggerty Phonemic Awareness daily. Kindergarten students followed a scope of sequence of phonics lessons from IMSE. First and second grade followed the UFLI scope and sequence for phonics instruction.
 - c. Clarksville Community School Corporation used Phonics First, an Orton-Gillingham based phonics program, to intervene with students in grades Kdg 3rd who displayed characteristics of dyslexia.
 - d. The Amira dyslexia screener determined the following number of students to be at risk or at some risk of dyslexia in grades K-2.
