Dr. Bennett went over the bond timeline. She reminded that board that next week prior to the public hearing the holding corporation would meet to finalize the bond. She let the board know that they would vote on the completion of bonds and would need to vote and sign on the bond resolutions. Dr. Bennett also let the board know that her and Dr. Allred would be meeting with a potential architect March 5 to discuss retrofitting Renaissance Early Learning Academy to fit preschool students for the start of the 2026-2027 school year.

Dr. Bennett ended her updates by letting the board know that the CHS Boys Basketball team would kickoff sectionals March 4 vs. Mitchell at 6:00pm at Salem and wished them good luck.

Dr. Allred mentioned to the board that WIDA testing was officially completed and that now we were just waiting on WIDA scores. He also let the board know that 2nd grade students started their IREAD testing, 3rd grade would soon follow. He let the board know that SAT testing was today and state wide, possible even country wide the college board testing was having issues with students logging in. He gave a shout out to Dr. Goldman, her staff and Mr. Crane for staying the course and working with college board and each other to get all but maybe 3-5 students tested. He mentioned that we were in much better shape than surrounding schools who were also having so many issues.
