

Call to Order:

Ms. Hauber called the Special Meeting to order at 5:02 pm.

Amend and/or Adopt Agenda:

Ms. Wilson made a motion to adopt the agenda, as presented. Ms. Cummings seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Education Update and Superintendent's Reports:

Dr. Bennett started off the night by letting the board know that Mazi Education conducted an English Language Learner program review for our district. She let the board know that Mazi is the company whom CCSC contracts with to assist us with our grant writing for Titles 1, II, III and IV. She mentioned that the review was conducted in February and the summary of the review was sent to CCSC in late March. Dr. Bennett also mentioned that the review gave her some great insights on the strength of our ELL program in the district as well as some recommendations for the district and building levels in order to continue to make progress in moving our ELL students forward in their academic attainment. She let the board know that Dr. Allred and herself would be meeting with the principals to discuss the components of the review in the near future then they will make decisions based on the feedback on that the next best steps are for CCSC. Dr. Bennett will continue to update the board on these items.

Dr. Bennett let the board know that she has received one request for a proposal for install and demolition for the Chuck Franz gymnasium bleachers. She mentioned that she will bring the proposal from Toadvine next week for board approval. She indicated that we had to follow the formal process for

request for quotes according to the public works law. The acquisition for the bleachers for the high school and middle school will be purchased through the Wilson Center.

Dr. Bennett has a few reminders and updates: She asked the board that if they were planning on attending the Top 10 Ceremony, please RSVP to either Lisa Wilson or Jennifer Bishop by Friday, April 10. The banquet will be held on Tuesday, April 21 at 6:00pm in the high school cafeteria. All board members indicated that they would be present at the ceremony. She reminded that board that the Region 10 Spring Meeting at the Pines is April 16. The Acadia is reserved, and that the plan was to leave at 4:30pm.

Dr. Bennett then went on to give the board a project update: She mentioned that we are making great strides with the 2024 bond projects. Four of the six bathrooms at the high school have been completed. D Lobby will be completed by graduation and the football field house is almost completed, they are putting one last top coat on the epoxy floors. The high school hospitality/food room is completed and furniture has been ordered. The weight room floor was installed yesterday. The weights will be delivered in early May. The video monitors are up and running. The middle school concession stand is moving along, the major construction is complete, we are waiting on cabinets and fixtures. She said that if you drive between the Chuck Franz gym and Steve Mathany Way the huge oak tree that was buckling the sidewalk has been removed. There have been about 6 windows at CES that were replaced where the seals were broken and the windows were foggy. She said that we are closing in on the last phase of branding at the academic wing at CMS. Next steps will be to repaint and rebrand both gyms and replace the bleachers in the main gym. The terrazzo floor at CMS is scheduled to be refinished this summer. Retrofitting for OMWPK will take place early summer. She mentioned that she was meeting with architects this week to discuss adding walls to studio 1 and 2. Beginning in the 26-27 school year we will have OMWPK and Kindergarten at RELA. Pole Barn will be painted to match the field house within the next two weeks. We will be ordering classroom furniture for first and second grades within the next two weeks with an install scheduled for this summer. Once completed, all grades K-12 will have new classroom furniture. We are in the process of completing the installation of new controls for HVAC at each building. RA and CHS have already been completed, CMS is in process with CES beginning next week.

Dr. Bennett informed the board that we will continue to meet internally with vendors for the other projects for the 2026 bond. Once she solidifies architects and vendors for the non-architect needed projects, she will update the board on the progress.

Dr. Bennet let the board know that we have a plumbing issue at the admin building where the piping was installed incorrectly when they built the place which was preventing complete flushing of waste.

Dr. Bennett let the board know that summer school will run three weeks beginning late May - early June. It will be 4 days per week, 3 hours per day for K - 12. The DOE is reimbursing approximately 70% for all levels. She asked the board that if they recalled this has been a new philosophy over the last few years in order to focus on developing students on the front end of their educational journey specifically with literacy and math.

Lastly, Dr. Bennett mentioned that Camp Invention will be June 22 - June 26. She is having conversations with Ms. Hawkins about CES hosting Camp Invention due to RELA potentially being under construction for the OMWPK retrofit.




