



How do I qualify for On My Way Pre-k?

- 1. Child Must be 4 but not yet 5 years old by August 1st
- 2. Child Must be a resident of Indiana
- 3. You must have a service need: working, going to school, job training program, job searching, SSDI, or SSI.
- 4. Meet the below Income Guidelines (before taxes):

What Documents Will I Need?

- ✓ Proof of ID for applicant/co-applicant
 - Government issued ID, state issued ID, school ID, employer ID
- ✓ Proof of ID for ALL children in the home
 - Birth Certificate, hospital-issued certificate, birth confirmation with date of birth listed, Valid Visa, Valid Green Card,
- ✓ Proof of residency
 - Driver license, pay stub, lease, utility bill, or piece of mail postmarked within the past 60 day
- ✓ Proof of service need:
 - pay stub, school schedule, job search form, SSI/SSDI

Other documents maybe needed upon approval of your application the project manager for your area will let you know if this is the case
